READ ANTIPASTO BEAN SALAD

PREPARATION TIME: 15 MINUTES — MAKES 4 SERVINGS

SALAD:

- 1 can READ 3 or 4 Bean Salad (15 oz)
- 1/4 cup Roasted red peppers, sliced into strips
- 1/2 cup Fresh mozzarella or provolone cheese, diced into 1/2 inch cubes
- 1 cup Chopped artichoke hearts (canned or frozen; if frozen, thaw)
- 1/4 cup Thin strips of salami or pepperoni
- 2 tbsp Chopped fresh basil

DRESSING:

- 1/4 cup Reserved liquid from READ 3 or 4 Bean Salad
- 2 tbsp Olive oil
- 1 Garlic clove, minced
- 2 tbsp Chopped fresh herbs (optional)
*Parsley, basil, thyme or other favorite herbs can be used.

1. Drain bean salad; reserve 1/4 cup liquid.
2. For dressing, combine reserved bean salad liquid, oil and garlic; whisk until combined. Add fresh herbs, if desired.
3. In large bowl, toss together drained bean salad, roasted bell peppers, cheese, salami and fresh basil. Toss with dressing. Serve at room temperature or chilled.
