READ CAPRESE 3 BEAN AND SALAMI SALAD

| 5 cans | READ 3 Bean Salad: 3 drained; 2 undrained (15 oz each) |
| 1 pint | Grape tomatoes, halved |
| 1 lb | Small marinated mozzarella balls, drained |
| 3/4 cup | Fresh basil, chopped |
| 8 oz | Dried salami, sliced |
| | Salt |
| | Pepper |
| 2 | Whole wheat baguettes, sliced |

1. In a large bowl, stir together the bean salad, tomatoes and cheese.
2. Just before serving, add the basil and salami. Add salt and pepper, as desired. Stir to combine.
3. Serve on a large platter surrounded by baguette slices.
