READ STEAK AND GERMAN POTATO SALAD

PREPARATION TIME: 15 MINUTES — MAKES 4 SERVINGS

- 1 can READ German Potato Salad (15 oz)
- 2 tbsp Coarse-ground Dijon-style mustard
- 1/2 lb Boneless top sirloin steak, cut 1-inch thick
- 1 bag Hearts of romaine lettuce (10 oz)

1. Stir together potato salad and mustard in medium bowl; set aside.
2. Heat medium nonstick skillet over medium heat until hot. Place steak in skillet and cook about 15 minutes until medium rare doneness (145°F); turn occasionally.
3. Cool steak; carve diagonally across grain into 1/4-in thick slices; reserve. Just before serving, gently toss steak with potato salad. Serve over greens.

NOTE: RECIPE CAN BE DOUBLED.
